# Let's Talk About Plants!

## Monstera News

*Beginner Plants:*



**Pothos:**  
Pothos is one of the easiest trailing plants to have in your collection. With many varieties to choose from and its simple needs, this plant is great for beginner plant parents or just looking to liven up a space. Pothos grows well in bright indirect light but can also survive in low light. With variegated varieties, they prefer more light to keep the variegation. They also do well under fluorescents.

Pothos like to keep their roots dry, water every 3-5. Wait until the soil is dry to water. The plant may even droop a little, that is a good indicator that it needs to be watered. Pothos don't need much fertilizer. You can choose to feed your plant some houseplant fertilizer bi-monthly.

This lovely plant is toxic to our furry friends. Be sure to keep it high an out of reach of pets.

**Pilea silver sparkle**  
**Pilea glauca**

These dainty plants are great for beginners. Their tiny round leaves make for a beautiful cascading plant if kept high enough.

Propagation is simple enough, simply place a cutting in water and once the roots are 1/2" to a 1" long plant in soil.

These plants need minimal care, they prefer bright indirect sun. Rotate the pot often to encourage even growth. Pilea Silver Sparkle have medium water needs, every 3-5 days depending on how dry and hot the environment is.

Pilea Silver Sparkle is non-toxic to your furry friends.
